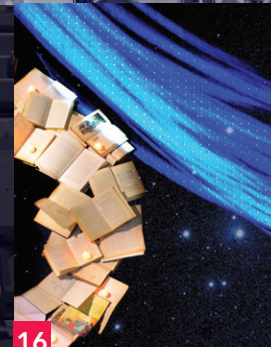

Mountain to Mouth Extreme Arts Walk returns on May 4-5, 2018. Be part of this extraordinary journey of discovery over two days and 80km with the creation of a contemporary songline. M to M begins at the You Yangs, crosses Geelong's industrial zone into the city centre then continues along the Barwon River to culminate at Barwon Heads. Along the way, walkers and communities come together to share arts experiences that celebrate our land.

The Spirit of Mountain to Mouth (M~M), Geelong's biennial Extreme Arts Walk, continues in 2017 with two featured events at Geelong After Dark.

**Connecting Song** - three unsigned acts have worked with mentors to create a place-based song and video clip. Their work debuts in Beav's Bar outdoor space.

**Constellation - River of Words:** a beautiful installation at City Hall.
